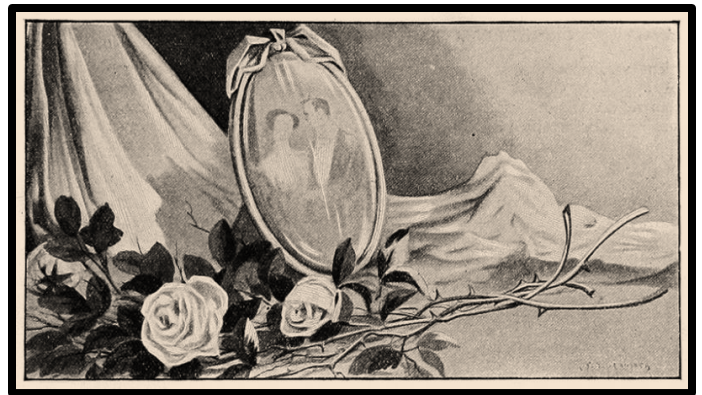




The Adventures of Sherlock Holmes Adventure III – A Scandal in Bohemia
